4. Radioactive Waste Management Grant

The company recieved grant funding from Radioactive Waste Management for replacing the Reading Rooms roof, totalling £236,771. Expenses totalling £222,275 were incurred during the year. Therefore grants remaining at the year end 30 November 2023 were £14,496.
